Wednesday, 22nd of July, 2015: arrival of the partners

All the partners arrived in Florence and housed in their hotels in the city center.

Morning of Thursday, 23rd of July, 2015: Meeting project in the “Aula magna” room of Palazzo Non Finito, the Anthropology section of the Department of Biology

The Florence meeting started with the International Symposium “Innovative methods and strategies in Vocational Education and Training for efficient use of resources and environmental protection”, with the participation of people from local authorities and national research institutions.

After the registration of all the partners, Prof. Marco Bazzicalupo welcomed the participants on behalf of the University of Florence, introduced the International Symposium and its scientific and social relevance, and presented the invited speakers. We had representatives from the Council of Tuscany Region, Sector of Forestation, innovation promotion and Community interventions for the agri-environment; from the National Research Council - CNR, Institute of Biometeorology IBIMET; from the local ONG Institution “Fondazione per il Clima e la Sostenibilità – FCS”, and from the Departments of Biology and of Science for Agricultural Production and Environment, University of Florence.

During the symposium, the speakers presented important topics as:

- Innovation in agroecosystem for sustainable management
- The ERIAFF network: European Regions for Innovation in Agriculture, Food and Forestry Network. Its activities for sustainability
- Biochar: sustainable solution for agriculture and environment
- Sustainability of the Italian Fisheries: is there a hope?

After the invited interventions, all the partners participated to the Symposium with talks about sustainability and resource utilization in their own countries.

Afternoon of Thursday, 23rd of July, 2015: technical visit to the farm “Azienda Agricola Poggio di Camporbiano”, San Gimignano (Florence), awardee for best practices in sustainability

In the afternoon all the partners enjoy the technical visit to the farm “Azienda Agricola Poggio di Camporbiano”.

Here we visited many sections of the farm, receiving depth information about their organic production of milk, cheeses, honey and hive products, seeds, vegetables and fruits. The host showed us the labs for milk processing and honey extraction, and also the greenhouses for seeds and plants production. Moreover, we visited the wheat belt with the ancient cultivars of cereals, that they are growing and reevaluating for being more healthy and environmentally sustainable, are stored.

We were instructed about good practices in cow and goat livestock, from the points of view of both animal wellness and healthy food. The farm is deeply involved in finding good practices for having an environmental and economical sustainable production model.
